We are pleased to announce that this year we will be offering students the opportunity to access information related to their courses using the Edu-Group portal.

The "my space" section of this portal streams information from communities (courses, clubs, teams) that you belong to into one location for easy tracking of recent homework assigned, due dates and announcements from your teachers and coaches.

The portal will feature the following:

## **Student Timetables**

This module offers students several options:

- \* Consult Student Timetable
- \* Print a Weekly Timetable
- \* Consult the Cycle Timetable

## **Report Card**

This feature allows students to consult their most recent report card issued by the school in the 2010-2011 school year. The report card is made available in a printable pdf format.

## **Course Assignments and Teachers**

This feature allows students to consult the list of courses in which they are enrolled. A feedback feature allows students to communicate directly with their teachers using the portal.

1. All teachers can be reached by email. To do so, click on the mail button adjacent to the teacher's name.
2. Some teachers make available a class website or blogspot which students can consult by clicking on the www button
3. Some teachers will publish assignment results. To access your results click on the results button.

## **Homework, Lessons and Notes**

This feature allows students to consult homework and lessons assigned by their teachers. This feature depends on the data made available by the teacher within their course community. Students are automatically signed up to their teachers' communities.

## **Team / Club Related Information**

In addition to the teacher communities that are being created for courses offered to the students a number of sports teams and school clubs will be offering communities containing information such as schedules, fundraising goals etc...

**Students are reminded that teachers are still in the process of setting up course communities. As new communities are created for your courses you will automatically be registered to them. Keep an eye on the communities tab to see which learning communities you belong to.**

We hope that this new online feature in addition to your student planner will prove to be a valuable tool to help you achieve your academic goals.
