



SCHOOL NETWORKS

Terminal Server (TS) and School Labs



In the D'Arcy McGee and Symmes Junior High building complex there are two networks that students and staff use:

- the 'Schools' Terminal Server (TS) network
- the 'Schoolslabs' workgroup

In order to access the 'Schools' Terminal Server (TS) network, you must first login to the workstation by using the following:

User ID: students
Password: students

- Once logged in, go to the 'Start' button => Programs => Schoolcluster (note: some screens also have the 'Schoolcluster' icon that can be clicked on).
- A connection box will open asking for your TS user ID and password. These were given to you in your advisory or hook, and normally are a combination of an initial from your first name and your last name.

Example: John Smith would be jsmith; if there are two John Smith, then one would be jsmith, and the other jsmith, and so on.

In order to access the 'Schoolslabs' workgroup, the user ID and the password will be identical, and according to the room number they are in.

For Example:
User ID: lab236
Password: lab236

From the above it can be seen that this login works with the workstations in room 236, and only room 236. Other labs follow the same pattern, and teachers are aware as to if the rooms they occupy are on 'Schools' or Schoolslabs'.
